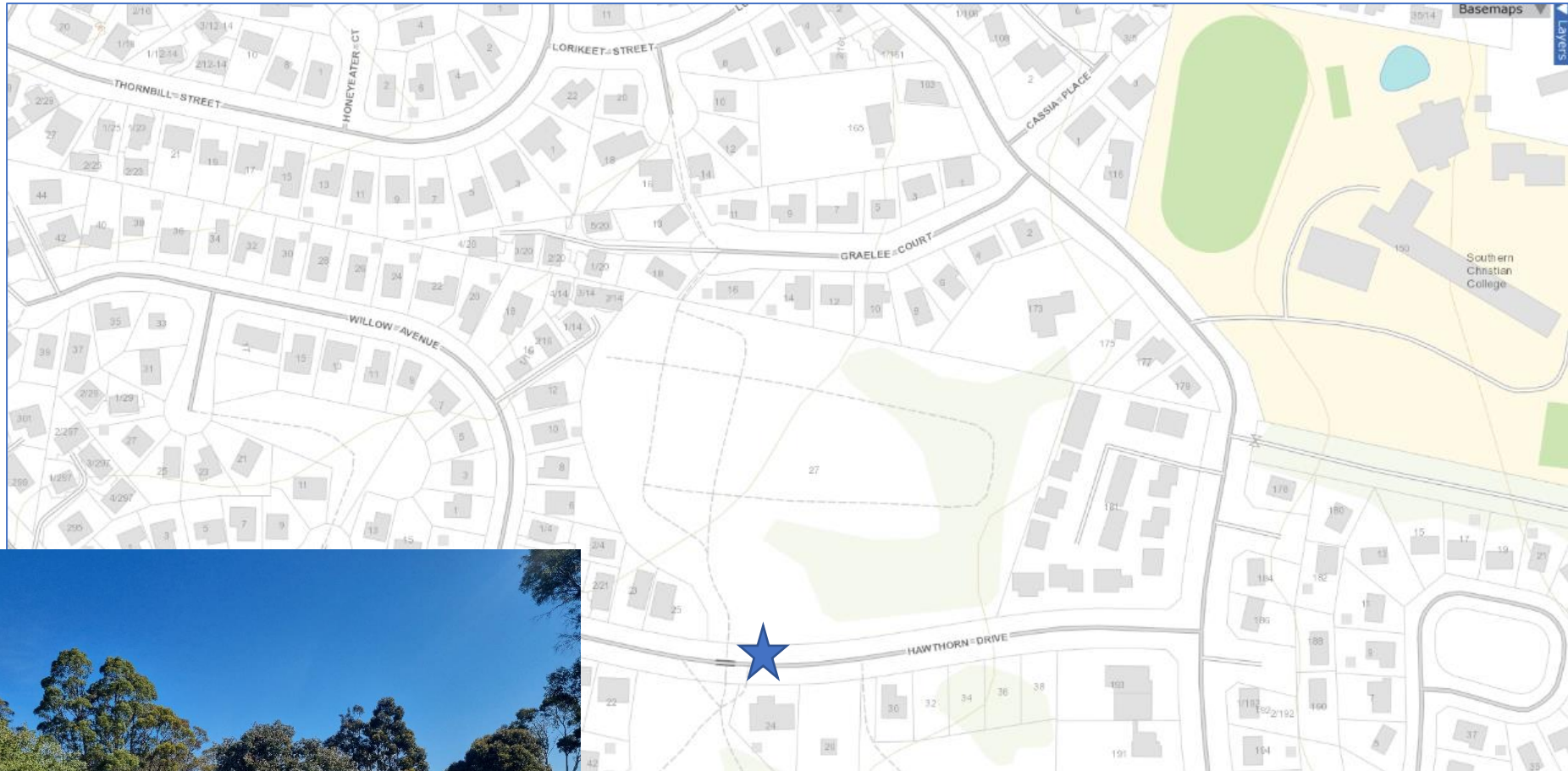

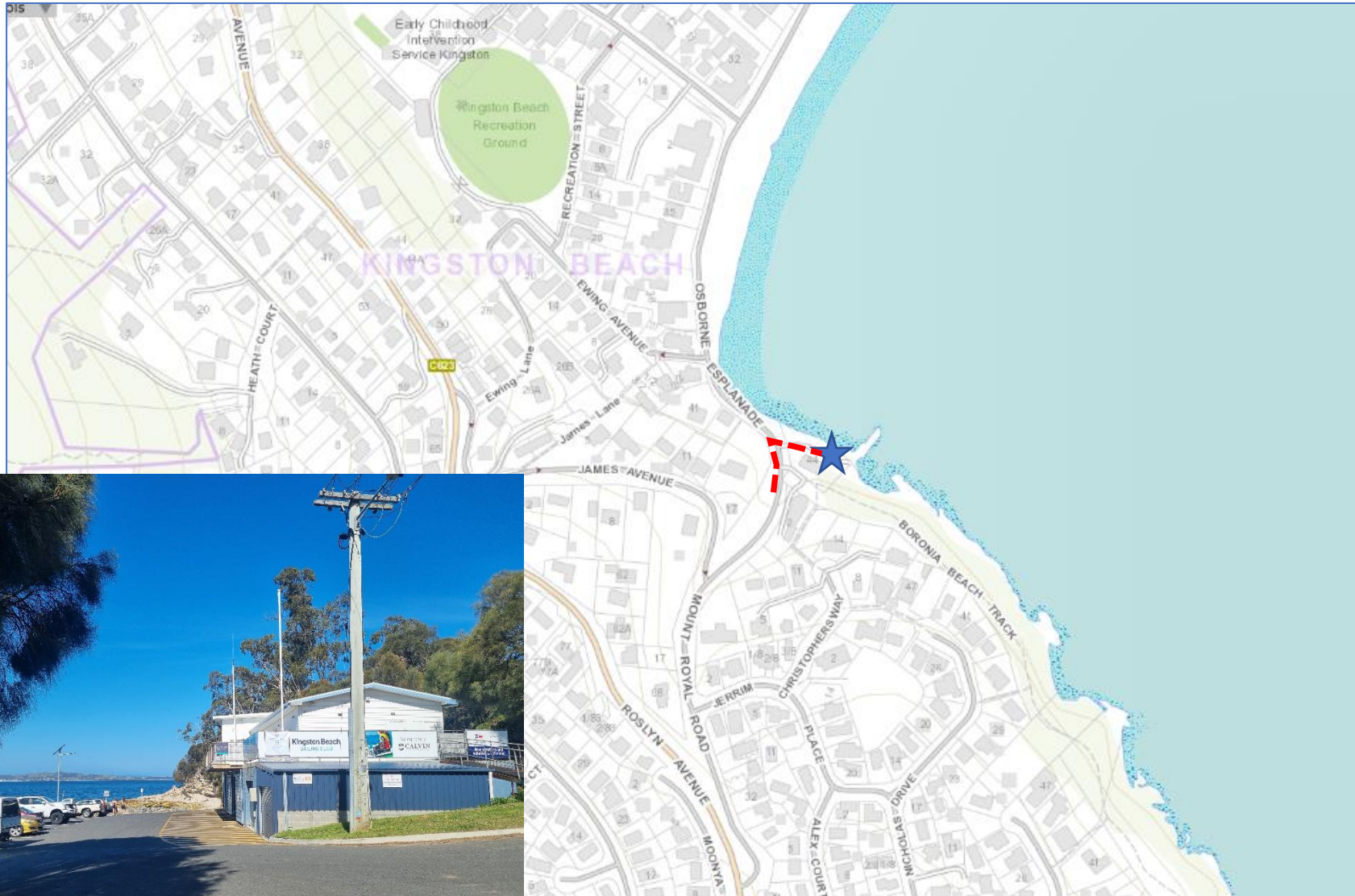
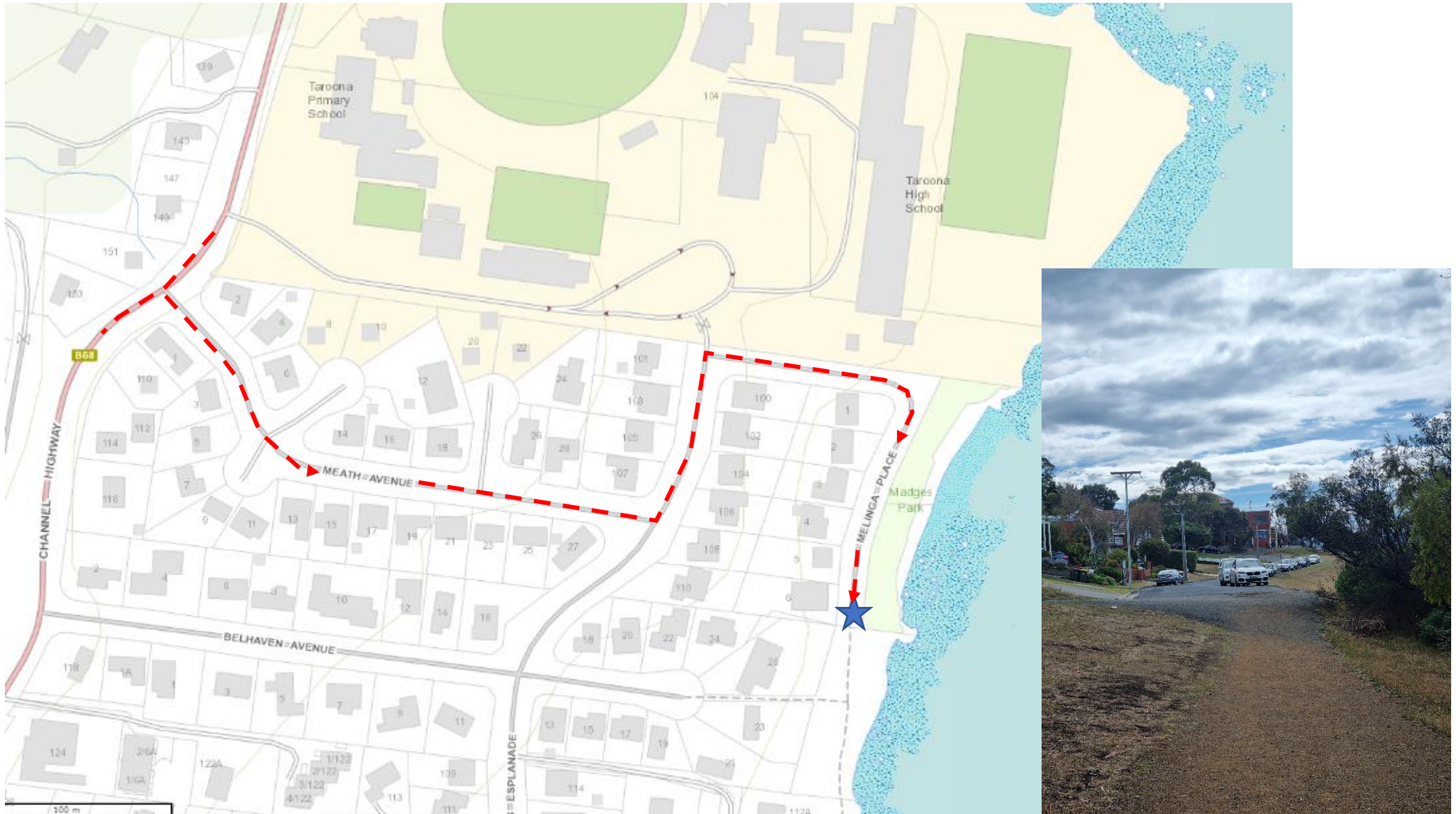

Access: From Channel Highway drive down Meath Avenue then left on to Flinders esplanade. Follow around the corner and down to the end of Melinga place.
