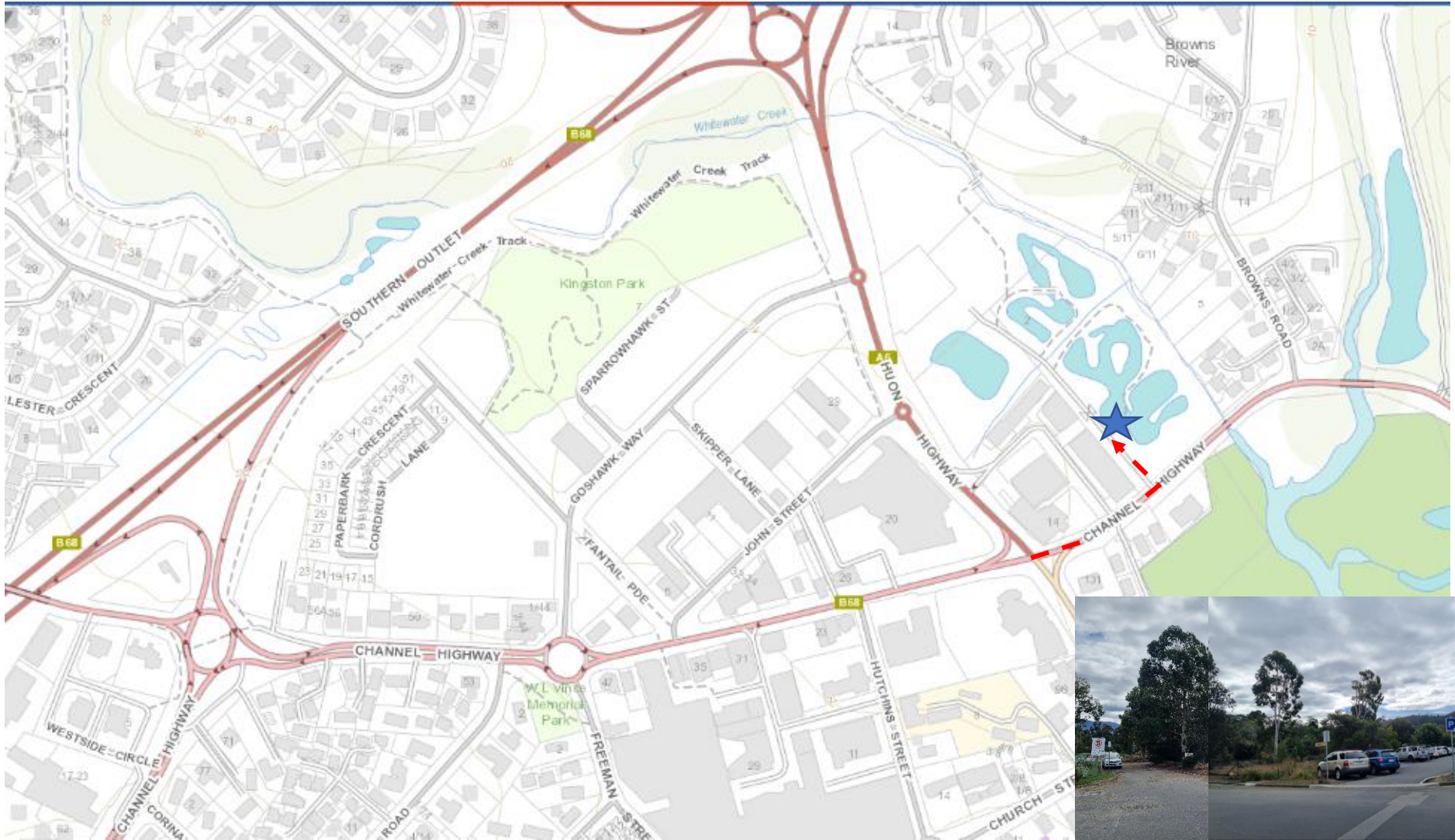


## 2<sup>nd</sup> Thursday of the month: Kingston Stormwater Wetlands

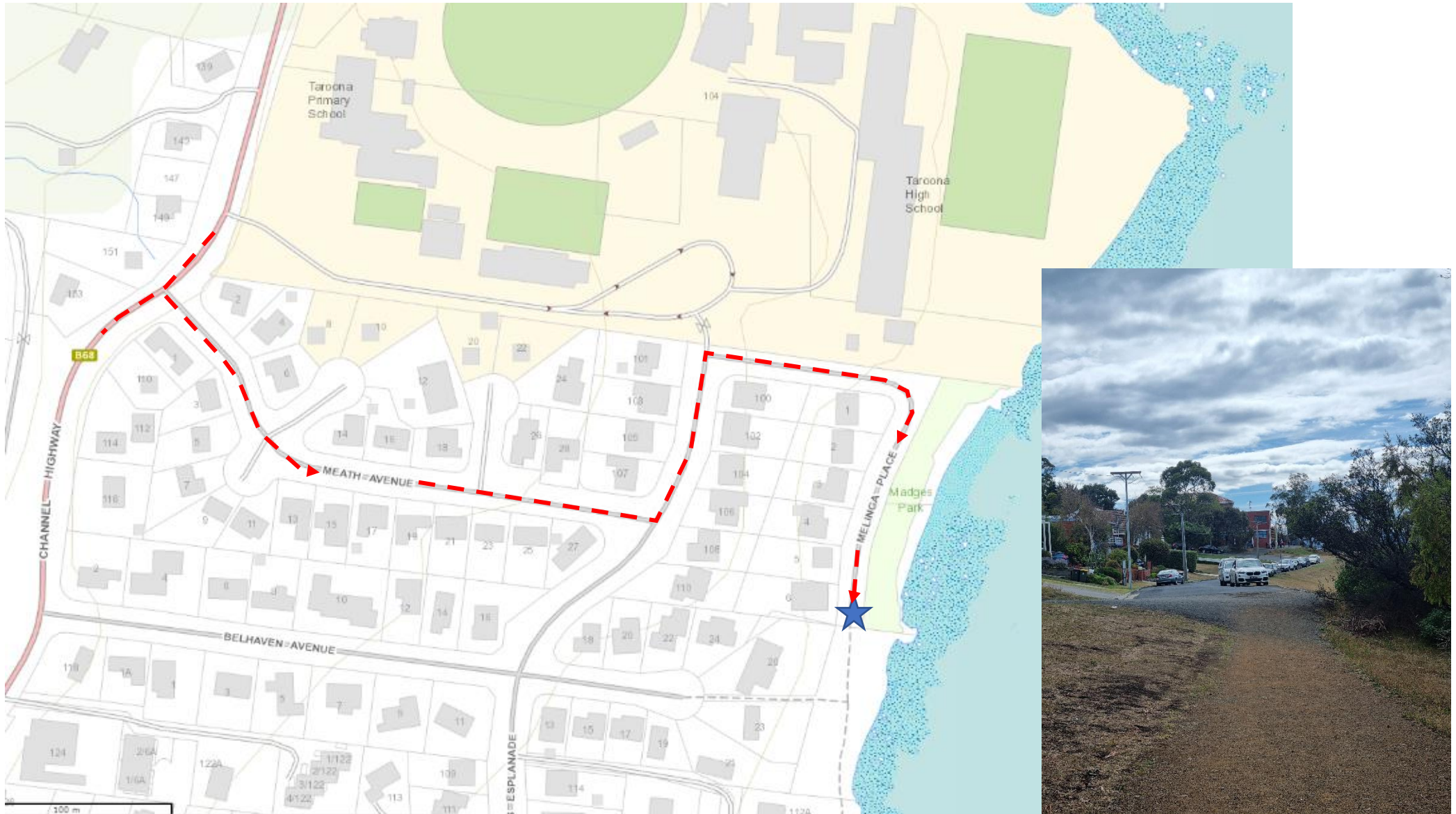
